Doubles League begins Sunday, January 17th

We'll be kicking off the 2010 club shooting event calendar with the Doubles League, beginning on Sunday, January 17th. The doubles league is shot each Sunday afternoon, and will run for eight weeks, ending on Sunday, March 7th. League participants will shoot 50-pair of doubles (two rounds) each week.

We'll award a High Overall trophy based on total score for all eight weeks, and also award class prizes based on your best seven weekly scores. The number of classes and trophies will be based on how many participants we have.

The doubles league is a great excuse to get out of the house on those cold but sunny winter afternoons. For those who have never shot doubles or would like to learn how, this is a perfect opportunity. We'll be shooting a lot of doubles during open shooting hours in the weeks leading up to the league, so there's plenty of time to practice before the league begins.

If you are interested in participating, just come out on the first week, we'll take sign-ups then. Cost of the league is \$20 for club members, \$25 for non-members. Your entry fee covers the cost of trophies and food for league participants on the last day of the league. You will be responsible for the appropriate target and shell costs each week.

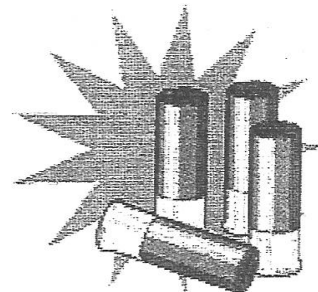
