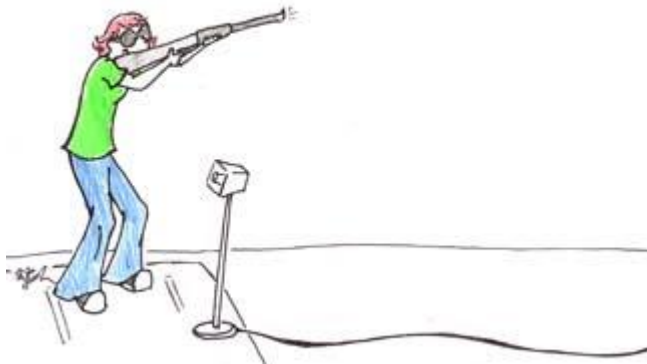

Comments from Bob Gibson

My name is **Bob Gibson**, and I am a Republican running for **DuPage County Circuit Court Judge**. The Republican Primary is on March 20, 2012.

I practiced law with a small firm for 27 years and tried cases in criminal, civil, chancery, and traffic courts. I represented individuals, developers, builders, and lenders in transactions ranging in size from \$40,000 up to \$80,000,000. The Illinois Supreme Court unanimously appointed me as a Circuit Court Judge in 2010.

I am proud to say that I recently received the Illinois State Bar Association's and the DuPage County Bar Association's highest recommendation ratings. Also, DuPage County Chief Judge John Elsner, in his State of the Courthouse address in January 2012, said "**When Bob Gibson was appointed circuit judge, he asked to be assigned to the most difficult call in the courthouse.... Judge Gibson has done a fantastic job showing patience and compassion, yet following the law.**"

I believe in honoring obligations. I have been married to the same beautiful woman for 23 years, worked for the same law firm for 27 years, and have been a member of the same parish for 40 years.

I also believe in honoring relationships, with God, with my family and friends, with my colleagues, and with the people I serve. I take my oath to uphold the United States and Illinois Constitutions very seriously, and that certainly includes vigorous defense of the rights conferred by the Second Amendment to our U.S. Constitution. To elaborate:

- I have a FOID card;
- I am strongly in favor of Illinois becoming the 50th and final state to allow concealed carry;
- I believe that gun ownership, hunting and target shooting are important parts of the fabric and traditions of Americans, and rightfully so;
- I believe that gun ownership among Americans can be a deterrent to both intruders into the home as well as any attempt at foreign occupation of the United States; and
- I am an enthusiastic support of Naperville Sportsman's Club and similar facilities.

As a judge, a lawyer, an arbitrator, a coach, a president of service organizations, and as a husband and father of four, I believe I have the qualifications and experience to continue to serve the people of DuPage County as a Circuit Court Judge.

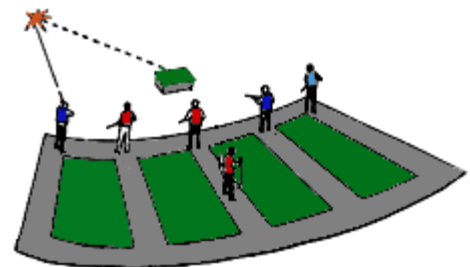
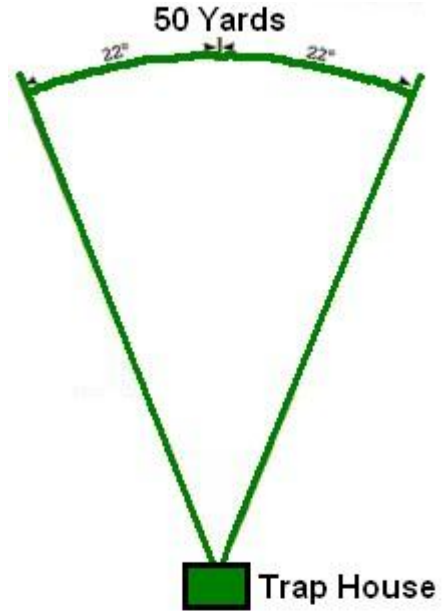

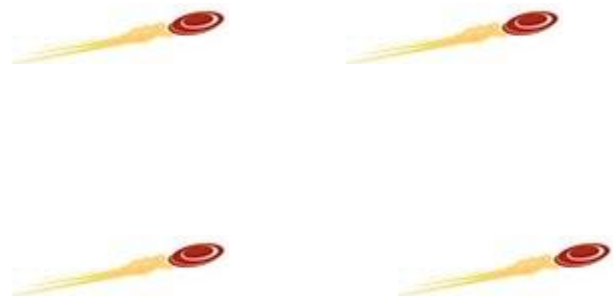
