Training Committee Report

(VSC - Volunteer Service Coordinator)
We are off and running. Since our former VSC for the IDNR made a mistake and posted the first two Field Day Classes we are offering this year. We have had very positive responses. At the time I am writing this we have 17 enrolled for the Naperville Sportsman's Club date of May 6th. We have 20 enrolled for the Newark Sportsman's Club date of April 8th. We also have a full roster for our first Naperville Sportsman's Club, Trap Fundamentals Class on 3/26. Our training season is looking very good.

As I have explained in the past; The Naperville Sportsman's Club Membership and the Newark Sportsman's Club Membership have provided us with the facilities and staff to keep the future sportsmen, law abiding gun owners, and stewards of our Natural Resources growing. As a direct result of those clubs and many others in our state and country, that mission will continue on a huge scale.

Since taking over as a IDNR Master Hunter Safety Instructor for Region II of our state and all your efforts, we have been able to fill counties with new Instructors, and Master Instructors, that have been empty for far too long. Firearm Safety Corner

As predicted the Illinois AWB has been slapped with a TRO pending the joining of several other suits in litigation to place an "INJUNCTION," on this nonsense. As described in my past articles, using the Heller, Brauen and "common use rulings will shut this down. That is coming to court on April 15, in East St. Louis, according to the ISRA. Let us not forget the 94 Illinois Elected County Sheriffs who announced they will not enforce or incarcerate under this law.

(There are 102 counties in Illinois - do the math)

I have found an interest in watching the ATF taking a beating from several directions in the past three weeks alone. I see regulations do not have the same merit as the law. I also see that California and N.J have taken a turn in losing their AWB contests also. Add to the plus column, three more states are on the verge of becoming Constitutional Concealed Carry States. They would make a majority of states with this title and laws supporting our Constitution. This would be a prime mover in the support of the 2nd Amendment defense.

I was listening to a David Webb show the other day and he made a very moving statement I would like to share. "Take out the 2nd Amendment from our Constitution and read ALL THE OTHER Amendments. ALL the other Amendments are directed to the individual's rights. Now put the 2nd Amendment back in. Wow! Ask yourself and those who represent you. Why are you trying to destroy this right? (Don't forget to tell them how to formulate an answer.)

Finally, I see several politicians talking about a "Safe Storage Law." We have had them on the books in the Federal, state, and some local laws for years. (I will not bore the law-abiding gun owners with the actual laws.) The efforts and monies used to foster these ideals could be used in much more productive ways, like I mentioned last month.

What a waste of our taxpayer dollars.






