Firearm Safety Corner

I had the pleasure of attending a seminar that addressed some recent incidents we are seeing in the press. They addressed the Bans on Guns and where it is going in June. The addition of another state to install Constitutional Carry, brings the number to 26 states. They anticipate another two states by the end of summer and a possible 30 states by the end of the year.

I can highlight the unusual actions being taken by the Federal Courts in these matters using the Heller and Bruen rulings, but as we will see; " it is just going to be another waste of taxpayer money."

These are all valid topics that ensure our Constitutional Rights, but I wanted to share an experience I enjoyed recently. For the first time in 9 years, I took a short vacation and visited my younger brother in one of the southern states for his birthday. We had a great time, but there was something else that I had not felt in decades. I felt safe! Virtually every person old enough to carry a gun, wore a gun. Gender did not matter. Style did not matter. The mood of the folks down there was fantastic and so friendly too. Courtesy, respect, and a smile are the norm. Absolutely refreshing.

Passing through the states to get there was also enjoyable. I did not have to worry about the correct carry for a loaded firearm in my car. BUT I should warn you to do your homework BEFORE transporting firearms through those states. They may have much fewer limits on your rights than Illinois, but some of the "Gun Free Zones," should be an item to address.


