# Firearm Safety Corner

We have all seen the response to the Registration Act. Unconstitutional laws cannot be enforced. I would like to discuss another topic we should visit from time to time. As Law Abiding Firearms owners we should be practicing responsible firearms care at all times.

Several years ago, while watching Duck Dynasty Willy Roberson said: "When the gun is not in my hand it is secured somewhere." All firearms should be secured to prevent unauthorized access, Homes that have children, neighbors and even maids, may run across a firearm not properly stored. There are local, state, and federal laws and guidelines that should be practiced continuously. An untrained adult is just as dangerous as a child when it comes to firearms.

Of course, we all practice the three basic rules of gun safety. Always keep the gun pointed in a safe direction. Always keep the gun unloaded until ready to use. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to use. Add to that: "Know your target and what is beyond it."

I should also mention: There is no such thing as an accidental discharge in the State of Illinois once the FOID ACT was revised in 2012. You can be charged with "Unlawful use of a Weapon." As Law Abiding Firearms Owners we should at all times practice safe gun handling.

Besides, ammunition is expensive, don't waste it.


